Elevator Project

We are steadily making progress toward installing the elevator. The elevator would allow for the upstairs space to be used as additional library area and community events. Thanks to generous donations from our community combined with our library development savings, we are optimistic about moving forward. The current estimated project cost is \$390,715.00. Our goal for 2025 is to secure state aid to offset the cost, with work potentially starting in 2026. An elevator will allow us to host advertisable and accessible events in the upstairs space for the community!

Summer Reading Program

This year's Summer Reading Program was a success! We had a dedicated group of readers who earned fun prizes. Our community event featured **Jeff Musial**, a local animal expert from Nickel City Reptile and Exotics, who brought a variety of animals for an entertaining and educational experience.
